

Kuwait Anti-Doping Agency Statistics For the Fiscal Year May 21 ,2021 to December 31, 2022

Introduction

The Kuwait Anti-Doping Agency (KADA) was formally formed on May 21, 2021, to execute the national anti-doping programme, in accordance with the standards stipulated by the international governing body, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA). KADA is responsible for ensuring that all athletes comply with the world Anti-Doping Code, which is the document that harmonises regulation regarding Anti-Doping across all sport and all countries of the world.

The main functions of KADA include the deterrence of doping through communication and education initiatives, the detection of doping through testing activities and investigations and the enforcement of anti-doping rules, by presenting cases of possible Anti-Doping Rules Violations (ADRVs) to the independent Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel.
